ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Deadline: 30th June 2022

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

The text must be clear, concise and written in proper English. The content must not have been previously published in academic journals or subject to peer review. Significant technical information must not be withheld. Abstracts must absolutely contain results. Statements such as "results will be discussed" are not acceptable and will lead to rejection.

The body of the abstract must not exceed **2300 characters**, spaces included.

GENERAL INFORMATION

<u>Deadline for receipt:</u> Abstracts should be submitted by 30 June 2022, 23.59 CET. <u>Confirmation of receipt:</u> Receipt of the abstract will be acknowledged by e-mail immediately after submission.

Registration: The presenting author of each abstract must register for the congress. Further information on registration modalities will follow in due time.

STRUCTURE OF THE ABSTRACT

Abstracts must be structured as follows:

- INTRODUCTION: a brief introduction stating the purpose of the investigation and its relevance;
- METHODS: a description of the methodology used;
- RESULTS: to be supported by statistical or other evidence to show their validity;
- · CONCLUSIONS:

Properly submitted abstracts will be sent to experts for review and selection for oral communication.
